

- 1. Exhibitors must park in the designated Exhibitor Parking area in the three rows along the south fence during the Show hours of operation. Otherwise, your car may be towed at the owner's expense. The rows south of the building and west of the WFCG Office are for Show attendees only. Handicapped parking is along the building sidewalk and on the east side of the WFCG Office.
- 2. Exhibits must remain intact until the end of the Show on Sunday at 5:00pm. Anyone tearing down their display before 5:00pm may be fined \$100. This is for the appearance of the Show and the saftey of the public in attendence. There will be no exceptions.
- 3. South entrance doors will be locked during show hours. Doors cannot be propped open during show hours. All propped doors will be secured shut. Exhibitors must use the Building G entrance during this time. Phone calls can be made at the north entrances where the public cannot enter.
- 4. Exhibitor agrees to install attractive display of their products and services. Exhibit materials including banners, signs, tables, chairs and products must not exceed 3' in height on the sides of the exhibit space beginning at 4' from the back of the exhibit to the front of the exhibit space. BOOTHS MUST BE SET UP AND WILL BE INSPECTED BEGINNING AT 5PM ON FRIDAY. If you exceed the height restriction you will be asked to remove or reconfigure your space. This rule helps to eliminate blocking your neighbors. In special cases, arrangements can be made in advance only if the event staff and adjoining neighbors are in agreement. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5. All TV, radio, stereo, musical instruments and other machines producing sound must be kept to a volume not to disturb neighbors.
- 6. Exhibitor agrees not to sublet or assign any portion of their space.
- 7. Management reserves the right to reject or prohibit any exhibit, part of exhibit, or proposed exhibit, including persons, things, conduct, printed materials, catalogs, or souvenirs, which in its opinion are not suitable for the show.
- 8. Show management assumes no responsibility for any goods or merchandise of any kind that are placed in your display. Exhibitor has sole liability for any damage or loss of any part of their display.
- 9. The driving of nails, tacks, screws or use of any method of attaching materials to walls, floors, railings or curtains is prohibited. Any damage caused by this will result in the exhibitor being charged for repair or replacement.

- 10. The exhibitor will be required to replace, repair or otherwise assume expense for any defacement or injury of premises caused by their exhibit or their representatives.
- 11. Heavy materials or equipment shall not be dragged, skidded or rolled over the floors, but will be transported with the appropriate equipment.
- 12. Exhibitor is responsible for any stains, scratches, marks or mars left on floor.
- 13. No highly flammable or explosive materials will be permitted in the buildings.
- 14. No open flames are permitted within the buildings except by management's, consent.
- 15. No liquor, intoxicating beverages or smoking will be permitted in the buildings at any time during the exposition.
- 16. No helium balloons or yardsticks may be given out at the Show.
- 17. It is understood and agreed that in case the management shall fail to open the show as scheduled, or to furnish space that the exhibitor contracted (or to substitute a comparable space), it will refund to the exhibitor all sums paid. However, if management is unable to open the Show, or is compelled to postpone or relocate the Show due to strikes, fires, casualties, acts of God, or other causes beyond management's control, then it shall not be in any manner financially liable to exhibitor.
- 18. Management reserves the right to adopt and set further rules and regulations as shall be reasonably necessary for the convenience and safety of exhibitors.
- 19. The management reserves the right to move an exhibitor to an equal space if their space should block the sale of multiple spaces to another exhibitor(s).
- 20. Exhibitor agrees to observe designated hours of the show.
- 21. Uniform set-up furnished by the management includes electrical outlets, lights and power service, janitor service (aisles only) and general lighting, all within the limits of the facilities of the Washtenaw Farm Council Grounds.
- 22. Company vehicles may be parked inside the west-facing fence by the road. Banners may be hung on the fence during the Show.
- 23. No dogs except certified service dogs are permitted.
